



The real work to protect Virginia's spectacular open spaces is teaching our citizens to care about what's in their own backyard. So, we launched the Ambassador Program to train Flora App power users to educate others on using the App to identify natives to protect, invasives to pull, and more.

To date, we have 22 highly trained Ambassadors, offering programs on identification of native and invasive plants in their towns and schools, and at events like the State Fair of Virginia.

Grant awarded to secure Flora of Virginia data


The Flora of Virginia database is a MASSIVE Excel spreadsheet – 180 columns and more than 3500 rows – and all updates to the Flora App are executed in it manually. This incredibly time-consuming process was managed by one brilliant person who retired from the board after more than 20 years of service. While other board members have stepped in, it is cumbersome, time consuming, and rife with opportunities for errors.

Moving to an institutional platform means we can update through functionality and menus designed for editing and review, improve data security, remove dependence on specific people into the future, and seamlessly share data with our partners. This move will ensure that the Flora of Virginia is sustainable, so this incredible resource can support conservation work into perpetuity.

The Virginia Environmental Endowment (VEE) understands the importance of this project for the future of the Flora so awarded a \$15,000 grant to kick off our database move project.
